Hannah shared Brad's suggestion that PUC have regular quarterly meetings. A poll will be emailed out to determine a date and time. In addition, the group decided to move the monthly meetings following Plumas County Fire Safe Council meetings to another location.

Hannah announced that a logo is needed. Gary shared his concept with the group. Mike suggested incorporating a drip torch into a logo. The group decided to solicit logo ideas from the entire email list and review any submissions at the next meeting.

Bob said that burn days will require two types of volunteers: those who are committed to staying all day and those who are there to learn/don't have ongoing availability. A discussion followed about how to classify the two types of participants.

Anyone participating in a burn will be required to adhere to a list of expectations. The first quarterly PUC meeting will be dedicated to drafting the list. A few suggestions for the list were shared including "be on time."
